

CLAMP-TITE OVERFLOW SCUPPER DRAIN INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Prepare a hole in the parapet wall that is slightly larger than the drain exit pipe.
- 2. Insert the drain into the hole so that the flange is flush with the wall.
- 3. Check to see that the drainpipe extends beyond the parapet wall a minimum 2".
- 4. Fasten the flange with a minimum of 4 broad-head screws, 1" in from edge of the flange, spaced 2" apart.
- 5. Rough up the copper flange surface and clean the flange.
- 6. Apply the roofing membrane to the scupper flange and seal according to the roofing manufacturer's instructions.
- 7. Bolt the clamping ring on using the wrench provided. Do not to over-tighten.
- 8. Outside the wall, connection or sealing by others.
- 9. Adhere to the installation requirements as determined by the regulatory authorities for your region.
