

GOOSENECK VENT INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Important: Read Instructions Before Installation.

FLAT ROOF - Installation for Pitch 2 1/2 Minimum to 3/12 Maximum

- 1. Determine the size of the hole required. The hole in the roof deck should be the same size as the opening of the base of the Gooseneck.
- 2. Cut the hole in the roof deck.
- 3. Remove any debris or materials that may prevent the Gooseneck flange from laying flush against deck.
- 4. Place the Gooseneck Vent on the roof deck ensuring that metal flange is flush with roof surface. The flashing flange must be secured to the roof deck by using a minimum of 4 round head fasteners into solid substrate evenly spaced, 1" from edge of flange is optimal.
- 5. Follow roofing system manufacturer's installation instructions for installing and flashing roofing membrane to Gooseneck Vent.
- 6. Adhere to the installation requirements as determined by the regulatory authorities for your region.

STEEP ROOF - Installation for Pitch Over 3/12

- 1. Determine the size of the hole required. The hole in the roof deck should match the size of the opening in the base of the Gooseneck.
- 2. Remove any nails that will prevent the vent flange from sliding into place under the shingles.
- 3. Cut the hole in the roof deck.
- 4. Slide the vent under shingles. Flash into shingles using proper roofing practices. The exposed flange should lay on top of the shingles as shown; as if the flange were a shingle.
- 5. Adhere to installation requirements as determined by the regulatory authorities for your region.



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
